The BVI Health Services Authority (a client-centered healthcare organization) invites qualified and professional applicants for the position of **MEDICAL SPECIALISTS** in the areas of:

- **Internal Medicine with subspecialties in Cardiology or Gastroenterology or Rheumatology preferred**
- **Obstetrics & Gynecology**
- **Hospitalist**

Medical Specialists will be responsible for the provision of specialist diagnosis, care and treatment at Dr. D. Orlando Smith Hospital and other locations as determined by the needs of the service. This includes involvement with any major accident, incident or disaster in the BVI. The Specialist is responsible for ensuring that standards of performance in the hospital are in keeping with accreditation requirements and evidence based practice. The medical specialist will be expected to provide on-call. The Specialist is also expected to participate in the clinical training, development and supervision of junior medical, nursing and paramedical staff. Interest and proficiency in a sub-specialty is welcome and will be encouraged. Three or more years post specialist qualification required. Experience in leading teams welcomed.

- ❖ MBBS or MD and Specialist qualifications from an approved training programme of a minimum of three years.
